




SKI TALES, They Learned to Ski at Monster Mountain

The setting, Monster Mountain, is a fictional resort with plenty of vertical thrills for skiers and snow-riders of every level. Trail names like Frankenstein and Yeti, reflect the monster theme of the resort. To bring realism to the tale, the author draws from her personal skiing experiences and from observing ski school classes and ski racing training sessions at a local ski resort. The plot takes the reader through the experiences of this group of beginner skiers, as they learn the basics of technique and tactics, including stance, turning, and stopping.
