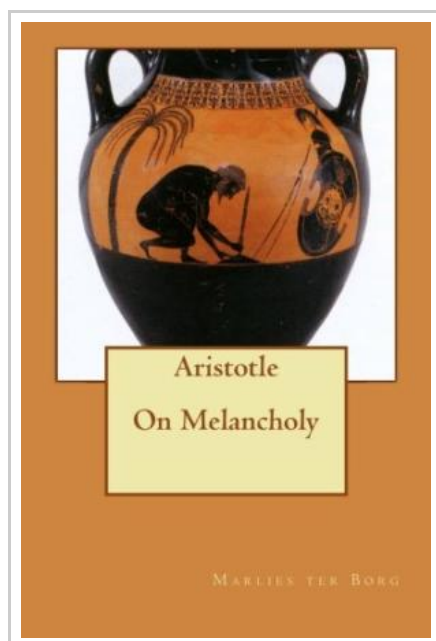




Aristotle on Melancholy
