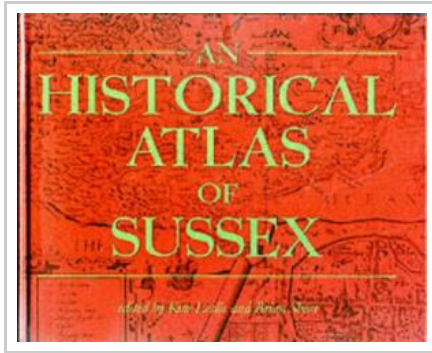




An Historical Atlas of Sussex (Hardback)
